

IMPORTANT HAULIER INFORMATION

Visiting the Port of Felixstowe? From January 2022* you will need to have passed a safety test to access the container terminals and collect/deliver your container.

The Port of Felixstowe has introduced a mandatory Driver Certification Programme (DCP) which must be passed by all RHIDES card holders requiring access to the container terminals. This has been introduced to improve safety for all port users.

Drivers need to answer questions based on the Haulier Information videos which along with the test itself can be accessed via the VBS website [vbs.portoffelixstowe.co.uk].

The specific videos to have watched are:

01 – Haulier Induction – Essential Safety Information

02 – Haulier Induction – Containers

03 – Haulier Induction – Remote Yard Cranes

***IMPORTANT!**

All **new drivers** requesting a RHIDES card will need to have taken and passed the test prior to being issued a card from Monday **29 November 2021**.

All **current RHIDES card holders** using the Port of Felixstowe Container Terminals must have passed the DCP by **Tuesday 4 January 2022**.

Any driver failing to take and pass the test by this date will not be able to access the Container Terminals and, if they are a current RHIDES card holder, this will no longer work and will have to take and pass the test to gain entry.
